David Bailey suggested using Abundant Life Church to meet as it has been offered free of charge (donations happily accepted). He thought the pastor would allow him to have a key. The church has room with 150 person capacity and screens in the sanctuary. Lewis made a motion to sign a contract with UUC for a year and see how meeting there works for everyone while a committee investigates other options; David Bailey seconded the motion. There was some discussion. Chris Richmond volunteered to work with a search committee.
- 6. David announced that he will be closing his landscape business and instead opening Jack Tapp's retail bee business at a location in Daniel Boone in January.
