Presentation: The Veterinarian's Role in Beekeeping – Dr. Rebekah Gunn-Christie

Janet Staats, OCBA Vice-president, introduced our invited speaker for this month's meeting: **Dr. Rebekah Gunn-Christie**. Dr. Gunn-Christie is a veterinary clinical pathologist who works for Antech Diagnostics, Inc. and is also a consultant for the Veterinary Information Network, VIN. She has given lectures at various veterinary conferences throughout the United States and has authored chapters in several veterinary textbooks as well as having been a contributing author to several veterinary journals.
